



Officers Present: Bob Holly, Roger Jackson, Greg Back, Rock Libby, Leonard Zumstein, Kevin Byrne, Fred Courier, John Cardoza, Mike Johnson, Dan Gorman.

Members/Guests Present: Rick Kindle, Al Kosters

Quorum: Secretary Greg Back reported that a quorum is present.

Minutes from Previous Meeting: Motion to accept the minutes as published in the newsletter by Bob Holly and seconded by John Cardoza. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer Report: Treasurer Leonard Zumstein reviewed Form 28 from last month and reported –

Checking = \$5,690.67

Cash on hand = \$275.00

Receipts = \$1,485.00

Expenditures = \$20.00

Receipts were \$20 from dues, \$105 from raffle proceeds and \$1,360 from Christmas Luncheon tickets sales.

Expenses submitted for reimbursements were from Fred Courier for \$49.40 printing/postage and \$339.00 for his Quark Express subscription 2 year renewal (desktop publishing program used for our newsletter) and from Rick Kindle \$231.93 for purchase of yard signs for the branch. A Motion to approve these expenses was made by Mike Johnson with second by Bob Holly. Motion carried unanimously.

Membership Report: Chairman Mike Johnson reported we had 48 total at our November lunch including 43 members, 3 guests and 2 for the program. Our membership count now stands at 87 with a median age of 77.5.

3 membership applications were received from Jeff Rose, Greg DeBree and Jeff Young. After review of the applications Mike moved to approve these applications with a second by Dan Gorman. Motion carried unanimously.

Committee Reports

Bocce Ball: Chairman Mike Johnson had nothing to report.

Golf: Chairman Ken Kajioka not present, no report.

Travel: Chairman John Cardoza had nothing new to report.

RV: Wagon Master Roger Jackson reported he has 15 rigs signed up for Jackson Rancheria.

Dine Out/Other Activities: Chairman Gary Toombs was not present but Roger reported that the next dine out would be in January at First and Main.

Recruitment & Publicity: Chairman Rick Kindle reported that he has yard signs available to members to place in their yards.

Al Kosters reported on SIR promotion opportunities in Hughson. We can get a free SIR booth at the Hughson Christmas Festival Saturday, December 6. A motion was made by Dan Gorman to approve this as a SIR event and also to spend up to \$150 for new SIR banners to display at the booth. Motion seconded by Greg Back. Motion carried unanimously.

Al also reported on other opportunities in the Hughson area. Samaritan Village would hold an event for us and we could also get time at Hughson senior lunches to present about SIR. Al will work with Rick Kindle to follow up.

Old Business: After a review of the schedule of branch operations Big SIR Roger Jackson went over the current lineup of programs for 2026.

There was a discussion about having the speaker/program at our luncheons go first or last. For the time being we will have the program first but try to limit to about 20 minutes followed by questions and answers for up to 10 minutes before moving on to activities reports. We will revisit after a few more meetings.

Roger gave an update on the Castle Noz event. Other area branches will be invited.

New Business: Big SIR Roger Jackson reported that 2026 branch officers will be installed at the December Ladies Day Christmas Luncheon. There was also discussion of using a golf cart provided by Woody's Golf Carts to shuttle members from parking to the Covenant dining room. There was a motion by Bob Holly to approve use of the golf cart with second by Greg Back. Motion carried unanimously.

After discussion about Christmas Luncheon raffle prizes Greg Back made a motion to approve spending up to \$750 for purchase of Poinsettias and other gifts with a second by Dan Gorman. Motion carried unanimously.

After discussion about the open Assistant Treasurer position for 2026 Bob Holly made a motion to appoint Al Kosters to fill that position. Dan Gorman seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Motion to Adjourn: Motion by Greg Back and seconded by Bob Holly. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 9:36am.



All docents receive a full training prior to



Our new yard signs have arrived, and we are looking for some volunteers:



and we will get a sign to you. I am proud of how the signs came out and we are hopeful we can gain some exposure to welcome in some new members.


