WINE TASTING - Russ Winton Wine Investigation for Novices and Oenophiles (W.I.N.O.)

I normally do not buy wine online. I belong to a few wine clubs that offer one cent shipping with case orders. But with the virus and home stays, wineries are offering amazing deals and people are just drinking more wine. For example, Wine.com, the nation's leading online wine retailer, closed the first half of its fiscal year (April 1 through September 30) with 176 million in revenue, representing 217% year- over-year growth. This brought trailing 12-month revenue to 285 million, a 102% increase over the comparable year period. Here are three picks for my

January 13 Wine Line:

The Steal- The 2018 Rosemount Estate Cabernet Sauvignon from South Australia is just \$3.99 at the Grocery Outlet. It's an easy drinking Cab and a perfect winter house red. Aussie wines are now a steal as China has levied a 215% tariff on their wines. I wrote a few columns ago that Lindeman's Bin 65 Chardonnay

was a just \$2.99 at Trader Joe's. TJ's and the Grocery Outlet have pretty good selection, almost all under \$5.

The Deal- The Caracol Serrano Tinto from the Jumilla region in Spain is \$5.99 at the Grocery Outlet. It's a 90 point wine and a Top 100 Best Buys from the Wine Enthusiast magazine. It's a red blend of 55% Monestrell (Mourvedre), 25% Cabernet Sauvignon and 20% Syrah. This Tinto is deep, dark, delicious and a great price.

The Splurge- If you can't find a decent Barbera go online to http://www.cooperwines.com. Cooper Vineyards offers a choice of several Sierra Foothills Barberas. The 2017 Amador County was a Double Gold and Best of Class winner at the San Francisco Chronicle Tasting. The suggested retail price is \$31 and is well worth it. Cheers!




