
**IMPORTANT: PISMO COAST RV OUTING GUESTS**

# WINE TASTING - Russ Winton <u>Wine Investigation for Novices and</u> <u>O</u>enophiles (W.I.N.O.)

Good news, wineries are open for tastings held outside. Seating is limited so call or go online to make an appointment, especially on weekends. Here are my 'Wine Line' picks for August 9th.

#### What's On Our Table:

The Steal: The 2018 Esteban Martin Garnacha-Syrah Blend scored 92 points and is \$4.99 at the Grocery Outlet (Merced). It's a bold red wine with a bit of heat on the finish. the 92 point rating and \$4.99 price reeled me in. I gave it a 86.125! The Deal: If I owned a restaurant, the 2016 Columbia Crest Cabernet Sauvignon would be my house red. At \$6.99, the Columbia Valley Cabernet is the real deal.(Trader Joe's) The Splurge: The 2017 Concannon Vineyards Mother Vine Cabernet Sauvignon has a touch of Malbec and Petite Sirah. It is full bodied with red fruit and mocha flavors, round soft tannins and begs for a NY Steak. Yea, it's a splurge at \$45 but also it's an excellent gift/celebration wine.
