

GOLFERS CORNER

The competition was stiff in our flighted individual match held at Eagle Springs on the 1st of March. A turnout of 59 golfers enjoyed the unexpected warm sunny day. In the closest to the pin contests, Ray Phillips took 1st on hole # 7 at 12' 9" while Tom Lean was closest on hole #17 at 3' 11". In all four flights, 1st and 2nd place were determined by

tiebreaker rules. In flight 1 it was Terry Dondero coming out on top over Mike Moyle, both with net 70. In the 2nd flight it was Robert Jones edging out Tom Lean, both with net 69. The 3rd flight had Charles Jaurigue over Robert Rathburn both at net 71. Flight 4 had Vic Froehmer on top over Robert Wilderson, both at net 71.


Since we had so many ties that had to be broken to determine our winners, how exactly does the tiebreaker work? The TPP (tournament pairings program) that our scorer Rich Colby utilizes through the NCGA follows USGA rules in that the back nine total net scores are compared first. (It doesn't matter which hole the golfer starts on in the shotgun format, the net scores for holes 10 through 18 are the first tiebreaker utilized.) If still tied, the total net for the last six holes (#13 - 18) are compared. If still tied the total net for the last three holes are compared (#16 - 18). If still tied the eighteenth hole becomes the deciding factor. If all these comparisons still end in ties, the NCGA rep that I talked to said a flip of the coin would determine the winner.

In the matches listed above, the 2nd, 3rd and 4th flight winners were all determined by the first tiebreaker (comparing back nines). In the 1st flight the contestants were tied on the first tiebreaker but Dondero was 1 stroke lower on the 2nd tiebreaker (comparing the last six holes). Thank goodness the TPP program on the computer does all these comparisons!

Reg Rosander was our monthly chairman in March who stoically served for five tournaments. Besides reiterating his comments of serving as a monthly chairman to get to know all of our SIR 159 golfers (August 2011)

he mentioned that our golfers should be sure to read their names in the golf press releases in the Fresno Bee in the Monday edition each week....it might be the last time your name appears in print before your obituary. :-)
