

First, let me apologize for the difficulty with the public address system at last months lunch-



The 3rd flight was a runaway with Rich Colby taking first with his 58 being the lowest net of the day. Vic Froehmer took 2nd with a fine net 63. In the 4th flight top

Ridge Creek in Dinuba was the sight for the kickoff of our annual Ron Rich Memorial Match play on 13 June. They will serve as 1st alternate to the two teams that are advancing to the sectionals at Poppy Ridge on July 26th.

The very next day on June 21, also at Riverbend, the four man team of Jim Morgan, Butch Evans, Nick Fierro & Rich Colby fired a lights out net 58.12 in the Area 29 qualifier for the SIR State Scrambles. Congratulations to this team that now advances to the State finals to be held at Shadow Lakes in Brentwood on August 13th.

Thanks go out to Howard Zinn and Joe Hushek who served as chairman and assistant for June. It came to Howard's attention through comments of some of our players that a few of our SIR golfers are consistently having a tough time keeping accurate scores. His advice would be the same that he gave the high school golfers he coached...at the end of the hole add how many wood shots, how many irons, how many putts. Another remedy is to make sure the low handicap golfer in the group is the scorekeeper. If the scorer suspects a golfer is shaving a stroke or more off his score, instead of asking for the golfer's score, he simply says, "I have you down for a ... If the golfer doesn't agree, now he has the onus of recounting stroke by stroke. (If the low handicapper is the one having a tough time counting his own score, someone else in the foursome should use the same method on him). All scores should be said out loud at the end of each hole, even the score of the scorekeeper. Let's all have fun out there...anyone shaving strokes is kidding themselves that other golfers don't notice.
