Hello Roosters, and Happy June;

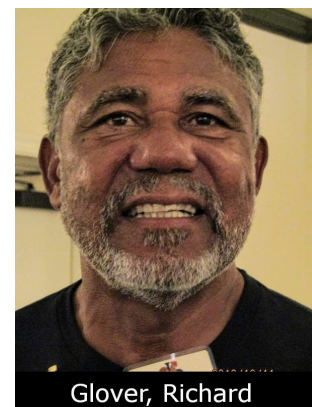

## **SIR Minutes of Branch 159 Executive Committee**

**MAY 13, 2023**

The meeting opened at 10:15 am at the Piccadilly Hotel. BEC officers present were Big Sir Richard Glover, Treasurer Bruce Corwin, and Assistant Secretary Brett Bayley. Directors present were Pete Openshaw (2023), John Briceno (2023), Mark Isonio (2024), and Jerry Brady (2024). Richard Glover proclaimed we had a quorum (7 of 12) and opened the meeting.

Next, a review of the April, 2023 meeting minutes was conducted. Bruce Corwin moved that the minutes be approved, and Brett Bayley seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Based upon inquiries during the calls to members, we expect 75 attendees at our luncheon today. It was also announced that two of our members, Manny Muñoz and Carlos Fernandez, had passed away recently. Additionally, our Little SIR, Steve Chase, is again hospitalized. Our thoughts and prayers are extended to all.

It was then announced that our scheduled speaker Ike Purcel suffered an injury and would not be able to attend our program today.

Next, the Monthly Cash Report (Form 28) was reviewed. Treasurer Bruce Corwin reported the financial activities during April 2023 involved several items. The general disbursements totaled \$421.92 for expenses. The receipts for our April luncheon were \$2,000. The cash balance at the end of April was \$8,642.91. Brett Bayley moved that the report be approved and John Briceno seconded the motion. The report was approved unanimously.

In regard to membership information, Bruce Evans presented the April Membership Report. The report showed today will be the 337th meeting of our branch. The report also listed two new members who will be inducted today (Michael Parker and Rich Morrissey). Their sponsors were Bob Price and Gary Lemaster respectively. Brett Bayley moved that the Membership Report be approved. Bruce Corwin seconded the motion. There was unanimous approval.

Bruce Corwin also announced that SIR Branches 175 and 179 would be merging with SIR Branch 169 effective immediately. This will leave two SIR branches in greater Fresno.

The final action concerned microphone time at today's luncheon. It was determined that Bruce Corwin, Bruce Evans, Duke Marshall, Brian Nicholson, and Fred Martinez wanted to address the group.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:40 am.

In flight 2 from the shorter tees Brian Nicholson won by 3 strokes with a net 68. In Flight 3 Bill DeMarinis won by 2 strokes with a net 69, and in Flight 4 Jimmy Ely won by 1 stroke with a net 74. The closest to the pin on hole # 5 was Loren LeBaron at just 9 inches and on hole 11 up the hill Javier Rodriguez was closest at 10 feet 2 inches. The low gross from the white tees was out-of-towner from Texas, Mark Hoffman, with an 84 and from the red tees the low gross of 81 was shot by Brian Nicholson.

Next on May 10th we were at Airways for a 2ManBB event that was won by Bob Price and Brian Nicholson by 5 strokes with a net 55. The closest to the pin on hole # 7 was Jeff Shahbazian at 1 foot 1 inch and on hole 15 Jimmy Ely was closest at 5 feet 2 inches. The low gross score for the day was 77 by Garry Elliott.

On May 18th, with the weather more like a tolerable summer day, we were a Dragonfly for the SIR 159 Team Scramble Championship with 13 teams competing. The team of Russ Anderson, Keith Lovgren, Rick Ransom, and Jeff Boatman won by 3.4 strokes with a net 47.8 calculated from a gross 61. 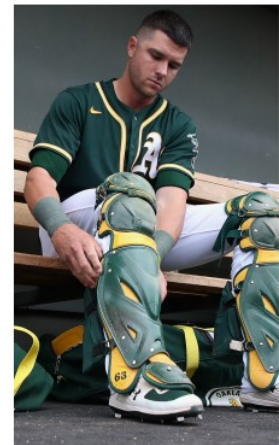
