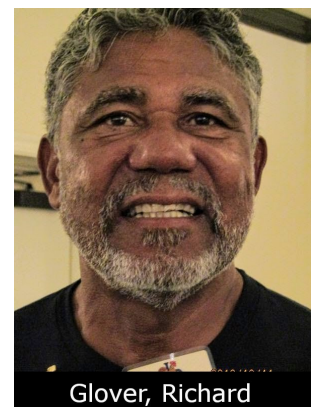

## **SIR Minutes of Branch 159 Executive Committee**

**June 8, 2023**

The meeting opened at 10:15 am at Pardini's. BEC officers present were Big Sir Richard Glover, Little Sir Steve Chase, Treasurer Bruce Corwin, Assistant Treasurers Gary Elliot and Keith Lovgren, Membership Chair Butch Evans and Assistant Secretary Brett Bayley. Directors present were Russ Conrad (2025), Pete Openshaw (2023), John Briceno (2023), Mark Isonio (2024), Jerry Brady (2024), Robert Ying (2025). Richard Glover proclaimed we had a quorum (11 of 12) and opened the meeting.

Next, a review of the May, 2023 meeting minutes was conducted. Bruce Corwin moved that the minutes be approved, and Steve Chase seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Based upon inquiries during the calls to members, Pete Openshaw indicated we expect 105 attendees at our luncheon today. 95 were reported to Pardini's. It was then announced that our scheduled speaker would be Ellington Smith, robotics and Artificial Intelligence (AI) expert who will be discussing the impact AI will have on us and society.

Next, the Monthly Cash Report (Form 28) was reviewed. Treasurer Bruce Corwin reported the financial activities during May 2023 involved several items. The general disbursements totaled \$59.07 for officer's expenses and \$2,880 for monthly luncheon. The receipts for our May luncheon were \$1,965. The cash balance at the end of May was \$7,718.84. Steve Chase moved that the report be approved and John Briceno seconded the motion. The report was approved unanimously.

In regard to membership information, Bruce Evans presented the May Membership Report. The report showed today will be the 337th meeting of our branch. The Membership Form 27 was also briefly discussed. The report stated Branch 159 had 173 members at the end of May 2023. Steve Chase moved that the report be accepted, and John Briceno seconded the motion. The report was approved unanimously.

As a positive senior outreach event, we will have a recruiting team at the event headed by Little SIR Steve Chase.

Under old business, Bruce Corwin indicated the State SIR organization would be tabling any further discussion about women joining SIR for at least the balance of the year. The recently conducted state-wide membership survey resulted in an overwhelming “no” majority.

The final action concerned microphone time at today’s luncheon. It was determined that Bruce Corwin, Duke Marshall, Brian Nicholson, and Fred Martinez wanted to address the group.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:50 am.

## NEWS from Your Golfing Community

On June 1st we were at Belmont CC for the first round of our Two-man Team Competition with a two-man scramble format. In Flight 1 the team of **Russ Anderson** and **Brett Bayley** barely kept ahead of the competition by .7 strokes with a net 61.3. In Flight 2 **Bill Scharbach** as a solo player was 6.1 better than the rest of that group. **Richard Glover and Robert Ying** were only 0.1 strokes better in the team competition. The closest to the pin on hole # 2 was **Mike Moyle** at 7 feet 2 inches and on hole 13 **Gary Morgan** was closest at 10 feet 2 inches.

On June 7th we moved to Valley Oaks for the Two Man Alternating Shot competition. In Flight 1 **Russ Conrad and Loren LeBaron** came out on top with a net 69.1. In Flight 1 the team of **Gary Morgan and Roger McCoy** moved ahead of the next closest competitor by 0.6 strokes posting a net 71.0. In Flight 2 **Richard Glover and Robert Ying** shot a net 71.9 increasing their lead to 5.2 strokes. The closest to the pin on Lakes #7 was **Dana Hamparzoomian** at 9 feet 9 inches and on Valley #5 **Russ Manfredo** was closest at 4 feet 1 inch.

The final round of Two-man Team Competition was played at Madera Muni on June 15th with a 2ManBB format. The team of **Jeff Shahbazian and Garry Elliott** made a run at the championship posting a net 62 that fell 2.2 strokes short of the winning team of **Gary Morgan and Roger McCoy** that posted a three round total of 201. In Flight 2 the team of **Richard Glover and Robert Ying** won the day with a net 68 and won their flight with a three round total of 207.8.
