Hello Roosters, and Happy July;



June 8, 2023

The meeting opened at 10:15 am at Pardini's. BEC officers present were Big Sir Richard Glover, Little Sir Steve Chase, Treasurer Bruce Corwin, Assistant Treasurers Gary Elliot and Keith Lovgren, Membership Chair Butch Evans and Assistant Secretary Brett Bayley. Richard Glover proclaimed we had a quorum (11 of 12) and opened the meeting.
