# SIR Minutes of Branch 159 Executive Committee

# **April 11, 2023**

The meeting opened at 10:15 am at Pardini's Restaurant. BEC officers present were Big Sir Steve Chase, Little Sir Mike Parker, Treasurer Garry Elliott, Assistant Treasurer Keith Lovgren and Assistant Secretary Brett Bayley. Directors present were Jerry Brady (2024), Robert Ying (2025), Russ Conrad (2025), Pete Openshaw (2026), and Butch Evans (2026). Brett Bayley proclaimed we had a quorum (10 of 12), and Big Sir Steve Chase opened the meeting.

Next, a review of the March 2024 meeting minutes was conducted. Brett Bayley moved that the minutes be approved, and Jerry Brady seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Based upon inquiries during the calls to members Pete Openshaw reported 91 members stated that they were planning to attend our luncheon today. Bruce Corwin told Pardini's to plan on serving 81lunches.

Little Sir Mike Parker then announced that Nick Davis, family farmer from Madera, would be presenting information about owl boxes and the use of barn owls in gopher/rodent control in agriculture.

Next, the Monthly Cash Report (Form 28) was reviewed. Garry Elliott reported a small net loss of \$130.10 in our Custodial Accounts due to luncheon cost overage. 
