




We have another excellent speaker lined up !!

### **November 18 Program**

The speaker will be Dr. Daniel J. Levitin -- neuroscientist, cognitive psychologist, musician, and award winning best-selling author. His research encompasses music, the brain, health, productivity, and creativity. He is the author of *This Is Your Brain on Music*, *The World in Six Songs*, *The Organized Mind*, and *Weaponized Lies*.

At our meeting Dr. Levitin will discuss his latest book, Successful Aging, where he turns his keen insights to what happens in our brains as we age, why we should think about health span, not life span, and, based on a rigorous analysis of neuroscientific evidence, what we can do to make the most of our seventies, eighties, and nineties today no matter how old we are now.

Program Topic -- "SUCCESSFUL AGING"

We should not lower our expectations during these later decades of our life. "Meaningful Aging" is another way to consider how to age well. Older age should be whatever we want it to be, and Dr. Levitin will provide some tips.

Dr. Levitin has published more than 300 articles in journals including *Science*, *Nature*, *PNAS*, *The New Yorker*, *The Atlantic*, and *The Wall Street Journal*. His research has been featured over 1900 times in the popular press.

A popular public speaker, he has given presentations on the floor of Parliament in London, to the U.S. Congress, Microsoft, Google, and Amazon. He has consulted for a number of companies including Apple, Booz-Allen, Microsoft, the United States Navy, Sonos, Philips, Sony, Fender, and AT&T.



He is Founding Dean of Arts & Humanities at the Minerva Schools at KGI in San Francisco, and Professor Emeritus of psychology and neuroscience at McGill University. He divides his time between Los Angeles and the San Francisco Bay Area.

As a musician (tenor saxophone, guitar, vocals, and bass), he has performed with Mel Tormé, David Byrne, Rosanne Cash, Sting, Bobby McFerrin, Victor Wooten, and Tom Scott. He has produced and consulted on albums by artists including Stevie Wonder, Steely Dan, Joni Mitchell and on the films Good Will Hunting and Pulp Fiction, and has been awarded 17 gold and platinum records.

David Levitin has also worked on and off as a stand-up comedian and joke writer, having performed with Robin Williams, placing second in a National Lampoon stand-up comedy competition, and has contributed jokes to Jay Leno and Arsenio Hall.

AND, he is from Moraga and was a student at JM Intermediate School when our member and speaker host, Ralph Blumenthal, was the school principal.

There is a formal process SIR leadership has put in place for the re-opening of activities. Each of our activities fall into one or more of the following four categories:


- 1. Some activities have re-opened and meeting in-person and/or on Zoom

The November Computer & Technology presentation will be on "Microsoft Access" by Dan Weller. "Access" is a program included in the Microsoft "Professional Office" suite. It provides the tools for creating Windows applications. This presentation will explain and demonstrate the main functions of Access: a

relational database, a clever data query function, a form creation tool, a report creation tool, a user-friendly macro tool, and the ability to read and update data in Word, Excel and external databases. Dan will also discuss when it is a good time to use Access and when you should avoid using Access

The meetings begin at 9:30am. The Zoom "doors" open at 9:15 AM so members come a little early to chat with other members. A few days before the meeting the members receive a Zoom weblink that is needed to connect.
