

The Speaker Program – "The History of the Flying Tigers"









Depending on COVID protocols, our **next meeting will be Thursday**, **July 22**, at the Legends Sports Bar and Grill at the Diablo Creek Golf Course, 4050 Port Chicago Highway in Concord, starting at 8:30 am. You can order breakfast and have it served in the meeting room.

Whether you fly fish, spin fish, troll, or bait fish, there will be events of interest. If you are new to fishing or are interested in trying a different type of fishing, we have experienced and knowledgeable members happy to share their expertise and even their equipment. With over 100 events scheduled throughout the year, some type of fishing is available almost every week.

<u>Fishing Report:</u> Trout fishing at our local lakes is ending due to the warm water but several members were still able to catch a few nice-sized trout at San Pablo Reservoir this past month. Karl Droese and five other SIRs traveled to Don Pedro Lake where they caught a nice mix of rainbows and Kokanee (landlocked sockeye salmon). Other members caught trout and bass at Lakes Berryessa, Comanche, and Pinecrest. Six SIRs caught a mixture of halibut and striped bass from a party boat in the bay. Others caught rockfish from a private boat outside the Gate. Striped bass fishing in the Delta remains fair with successful catches for several members plus a bonus sturgeon.

<u>Coming up:</u> Our annual auction of member donated equipment will be held during our July meeting with lots of bargains. On our July fishing calendar, we have scheduled several salmon, halibut, striped bass, and rockfish trips in the Bay and ocean as well as a couple of black bass trips to the Delta. Also scheduled are pier fishing, a shark/potluck trip, and a 3-day outing for kokanee at Stampede Reservoir near Lake Tahoe.
