- 2. Division #2 John Boyer Annual Meeting held and we discussed audits as a topic. Also discussed the SSGC Survey. State tournaments cost was discussed and it was felt they were too costly. Went over the golf manual and covered the website.
- 3. Division #3 Bill Ikerd –Annual Meeting was discouraging as I could only discuss our division tournaments, not state tournament. Only 15 people present. Discussed the SSGC Survey. My division does not participate in state tournaments. It would be useful to know why.

- 1. Sample Flier the Reno flier has not been seen it yet. Tony (Atlantis point person) was contacted and she said it will be out in a day or two, which may make it late to make changes.
- 2. Jerry Strain discussion dinner or 2 cocktail parties, scramble format? The group had a split interest, some want to keep the dinner, some want to go to cocktail party. Scramble format is the most popular with higher handicap golfers. Other formats that require individual play seem to interest lower handicap golfers. Survey was 80% for scramble, 20% non-scramble. It was decided we will use the scramble format for 2015.

- Bill Ikerd Black Lake. This is in Nipomo, south of Pismo Beach. \$44.00 for 18 holes including cart. His SIRs used to go there but left because the lodging (Santa Maria Inn) was too old. There are several hotels around Santa Maria. The golf GM has contacts for all hotels around.

There is a cap which if not exceeded your eligibility is not threatened.
