2. (MS) Welcomed State President Stu Williams and Vice President Rick Kindle

- 3. (MS) A document entitled "SIR Back to Golf Protocol During Covid 19 Pandemic (rev. 1-22-21)" will be disseminated to all appropriate Big and Little SIRs. This gives branches conditional approval and guidelines for reopening golf.
 - a. (MS) reviewed the document and answered questions regarding it.
 - b. (SW) This document applies only to golf. Other outdoor activities will be handled separately.

The General Meeting was adjourned at 10:25. The golf committee continued its meeting afterward.

A. <u>Treasurer's Report: (SJ):</u>

- 1. (SJ) to get access to all bank accounts to pay a \$95 service fee, he unsuccessfully attempted to deal in person at the bank. The fee is offset by a deposit from the 2% cashback account.
- 2. The annual audit has been accomplished.

B. Handicaps (JT):

- 1. He is still working on handicap issues. (See below)
- 2. (PM) needs a list of branch golf officers. (MS) This will be a topic for the next area meeting.
- C. <u>Zoom accounts:</u> (BE) asked how to get a Zoom account. (MS) informed that the Golf Committee uses the state account. (SJ) Each area has its account.

D. 2021Tournaments:

- 1. Reno. (MS) Is the Reno tournament viable if no hotel is reserved and people "did their own thing?"
 - (PM) Golf is currently shut down in Reno.
 - -(DP) Would the current golf protocol prevent a tee time tournament? A general discussion followed regarding the logistics of tee times.

- No action followed.
- E. Handicaps: (JT) Presented a list of possibilities to handle handicaps distribution for SIR
 - 1. Issues discussed were (a) the distribution of members among the flights; and (b) the highest handicap number that a member could play.
 - (JT) suggested 45, which is nine stokes below the current maximum of 54, and suggested proposal 3A. That would allow for a distribution of 25% among the flights.
 - Various motions were made and amendments suggested. All were withdrawn before that made by (DP),
 - 2. Motion: Made by (DP). Second by (JT):

The following handicaps and flights shall be established:

a) Handicaps for flights:

A flight: 0-17

B flight: 17.1-22

C flight: 22.1-27

D flight: 27.1 and above

- b) All players in a SIR tournament shall play to a 45 handicap or less.
- Motion approved unanimously.
- 3. (PM) Requested that all branch handicap chairmen allow access to him through the GHIN portal to get current monthly information.
