The duplicate bridge group met on November 5th at the Diablo Valley Bridge Center , with 11 teams playing. First place was won by the team of Conrad Robertson /Ron Wolberg with 67.97 points out of a possible 108, (62.94 %). Second place was taken by the team of Dan Greenberg / Norm Schoenfeld (61.35%). Third place was won by Arnold Jacobsen/Jim Regan (55.11 %). In fourth place was Ernie Sherne/Don Sturmer (51.76 %) and in fifth place was Jack Butler / Art Donaldson (50.44 %).

On November 12th, the lunch / bridge group met at Round Hill C.C. with 24 men enjoying lunch and 3 hours of bridge. Jack Butler with 6,890 points was our top score for the day, Rudy Gebert was second with 6,410. In third place was Lytton DeSilva with 5,940, followed by Ron Wolberg at 5,910 and Milt Greenstein with 5,670. We had 4 small slams today by the teams of Milt Greenstein/Rudy Gebert, Ron Wolberg/Tony Rohrs, Ron Wolberg / Marv DeHues and Tony Rohrs / Lou Sandor.

On November 26, the group met again at Diablo C.C., 20 men attending. After lunch, we had a very good scoring day with 5 small slams made. Ali Aghaiepour was our high scorer with 2 small slams and 7,730 points, (after missing 1 1/2 months due to surgery. Welcome back, Ali !). His slam Partners were Jon Dickson and Bud Grisanti. In second place was Dimitris Argyriou with 2 small slams, both with Milt Greenstein and 1 small slam with Oscar Krikorian for 6,850 points.
